# a quiet companion

The sculpture "Impact" offers a steady moment of alignment in your daily life. Its spheres hold a subtle vibration that invites you to return to what truly resonates. The sculpture doesn't ask for attention - it gently shapes the atmosphere around it. Over time, it becomes a quiet companion in your home, a point of clarity you meet again and again.



Impact (resonance, every day) begins with a simple gesture: a hand that moves a sphere. Nothing in the sculpture is fixed. Each sphere can be shifted, exchanged, or placed in a new position — and with every small adjustment, the entire composition changes. What was central becomes peripheral. What was quiet suddenly draws the eye. Even the red sphere may find itself at the centre, or not. The choice belongs to the viewer.

This playful rearrangement is not symbolic or prescriptive. It simply reveals how easily focus shifts — how a tiny movement can redirect attention, tension, or meaning. The sculpture becomes a field where the viewer's own decisions leave a trace, where their touch creates a new constellation that didn't exist a moment before.

Impact does not offer conclusions. It opens possibilities. It invites the viewer to notice what draws them in, what they place at the centre, what they move aside, and how these choices subtly alter the whole.

In a home, Impact becomes a quiet companion. Its spheres invite occasional rearrangement — not as a task, but as a moment of curiosity. Over time, these small interactions create a personal dialogue: a shifting reflection of where one's focus rests, and how even the smallest impact can reshape what surrounds it.

Ivo Meier, born 24 December 1969

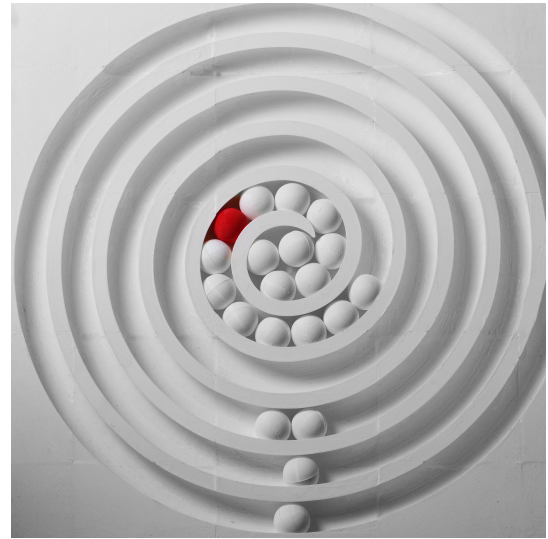
The early death of his brother at the age of twenty marked a decisive turning point for Ivo Meier. Although his Nikon had accompanied him before, it was this loss that led to a deeper engagement with the human condition. His first creative steps emerged through figurative drawing, driven by the desire to explore existential questions visually.

During this formative period, Meier travelled to various European metropolises and immersed himself in the works of major impressionist sculptors. Encountering the expressive power and physicality of these sculptures - especially those by Rodin, Claudel, and their contemporaries - profoundly shaped his understanding of form and artistic impact. What followed were years of experimentation with different media: photography, plaster, bronze, and concrete - always with the human being at the centre. Each technique opened new perspectives and contributed to the development of his artistic stance.

From 2016 onward, this process gave rise to an increasingly abstract visual language that defines his work today. It merges digital creation with a clear focus on inner processes, perception, and human experience. Meier's sculptures are rooted in an internalised vision of the final form, yet they evolve intuitively throughout the process. His works pose questions without prescribing answers, creating spaces for individual reflection. At their core lie deeply human themes: identity, inner freedom, values, and the relationship between the inner and outer worlds.

Informed by his artistic skill and vision, personal experiences, leadership background, and the ongoing exchange with his psychotherapist partner, Meier has developed a distinctly personal artistic language that moves naturally across boundaries and grows from the interplay of inner and outer worlds - Liminal Resonance.

His artistic vision is unmistakable: art making you think!



Sculpture Impact

Impact is digitally modelled and brought into the physical world through 3D printing, forming a composed wall-sculpture of a primary body, movable spheres mounted on MDF. Its interactive design invites subtle engagement: the spheres can be gently rearranged, allowing small shifts in position to alter the sculpture's balance and presence. These quiet movements become part of the viewing experience, revealing how easily a composition transforms through the viewer's own touch. The work is produced in a limited edition of five and comes with a certificate of authenticity.

A smaller edition of the sculpture is available (30 x 30 x 6 cm, mounted on MDF), designed to be shown on the wall or freestanding on a pedestal. It forms part of the Sweetspot series, where the core idea of the larger work is captured in a concentrated, intimate scale.
